Free transport will be given in the following circumstances: -

Primary schools

To any child from a *low income family where the distance between the home and the **designated school is more than two miles. Please note there is no policy of support for children attending primary school for religious reasons.

Secondary schools

To any child from a *low income family where the distance between the home and the **designated school is more than two miles.

To any child from a *low income family where the child is attending one of the three nearest schools to the home provided the distance is between two and six miles.

To any child from a *low income family attending the nearest or designated church aided school on ***religious grounds where the distance from the home to the school is more than two miles but less than fifteen miles.

*Low income is defined as being a child entitled to free school meals or the family are in receipt of their maximum level working tax credit. Parents of children entitled to free meals must supply their National Insurance number and date of birth in the relevant section of the form. If not receiving free school meals, parents will need to send a **full** copy of their tax credit award notice (TC602 or TC603R) from the HM Revenue and Customs.

The **designated school means either the school suitable to your child's age, ability and aptitude which serves your area, or if there is more than one school, the nearest school to your home which is considered suitable for your child and at which a place is available.

***Religious grounds are defined as being where a parent has decided their child should attend a church aided secondary school in relation to their religion or belief. To satisfy this qualification parents should provide either a copy of the baptismal certificate for the child concerned or for themselves or a signed statement from a religious leader confirming commitment to that faith.

If you believe your child is eligible for transport, please complete this form and return it to the address given, together with the relevant evidence where required. Transport cannot be granted until the correct proof has been supplied. Once an application for assistance has been agreed, please allow 10 working days for the transport arrangements to be made.

Once agreed, transport is granted for the whole of an academic year unless you move house or your child changes school. Cases are reviewed annually and up to date evidence maybe required before assistance can continue in the following school year.

Transport will be in the form of a season ticket for use on public services (bus and rail) or, if no suitable public service is available, we will allocate a seat on a vehicle under contract to the County Council. Assistance is not normally given to parents who prefer to make their own arrangements.
