Scholarship Information

A £5,000 fee waive for a student who will contribute to the economic or social development of their country when they return on completion of their studies.

Eligibility Criteria

In order to be considered for the Economic and Social Development scholarship you must meet <u>all</u> of the following criteria:

- Be nationals from, and resident in, one of the following countries: India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka. Students currently studying in the UK (including as undergraduates at Sussex) are not eligible to apply
- Be applying for a Master's degree in the following subject areas only: Anthropology, Development
 Studies/International Development (including the Institute of Development Studies), Economics, Education
 (including MA in Childhood and Youth Studies), Gender Studies, International Relations, Human Rights,
 Migration Studies
- Not previously have studied at degree level in the UK.
- Be classified to pay fees at the 'overseas' rate.

You will <u>not</u> be eligible for this scholarship if you meet <u>any</u> of the following exclusions:

Hold any other University of Sussex scholarship.

Assessment Criteria

Applications will be ranked and assessed on the following criteria:

• Awards will be made on the basis of academic merit and future potential in either economic development activity or social development activity in your home country.
